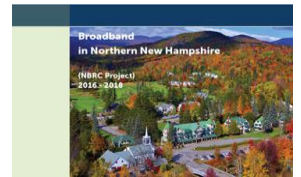

The agenda includes:

I. Broadband Overview (20min)

- A. **Current Broadband Availability** – Fay Rubin, GRANIT Project Director, UNH, will provide an update on the status of broadband availability based on FCC mapping data, and will highlight New Hampshire Broadband Mapping & Planning Program (NHBMPP) efforts in the region.
- B. **Broadband Technologies** – Dr. Scott Valcourt, Director of Strategic Technology, UNH, will review fiber-based and wireless technologies necessary for building and connecting to high speed Internet networks and services. He will also provide a brief update on NH FirstNet and the NH School Connectivity Initiative (NHSCI) projects.



II. Cable TV Franchises/Maximizing Opportunities for Municipalities (30min)



Attorney Katherine B. Miller, Partner at DTC Lawyers, will address options for negotiating additional build-out of cable TV systems to provide broadband to homes and businesses in unserved or underserved areas.



III. Wireless Broadband/Permitting Towers and Antennae (30min)



Attorney Justin L. Pasay, Non-Equity Partner at DTC Lawyers, will present an overview of evolving state and federal laws on permitting cell towers, and opportunities for more flexibly locating wireless antennae on a variety of structures to reduce impacts on communities and enhance broadband deployment.
